



School Dress Code 2017-2018

Washington Contemporary Ballet requires a dress code that allows instructors to clearly evaluate technique and make corrections. Leotard color is based upon class placement as listed below. Leotard can be tank, camisole, short, long or three quarter-sleeved. Not Permitted: Leotards with ruffles, bows, skirts, flowers or puffy sleeves. Jewelry should be left at home. Two small, stud-style earrings only are allowed.

Hair
